

CBSE-INTEL 'AI FOR YOUTH '

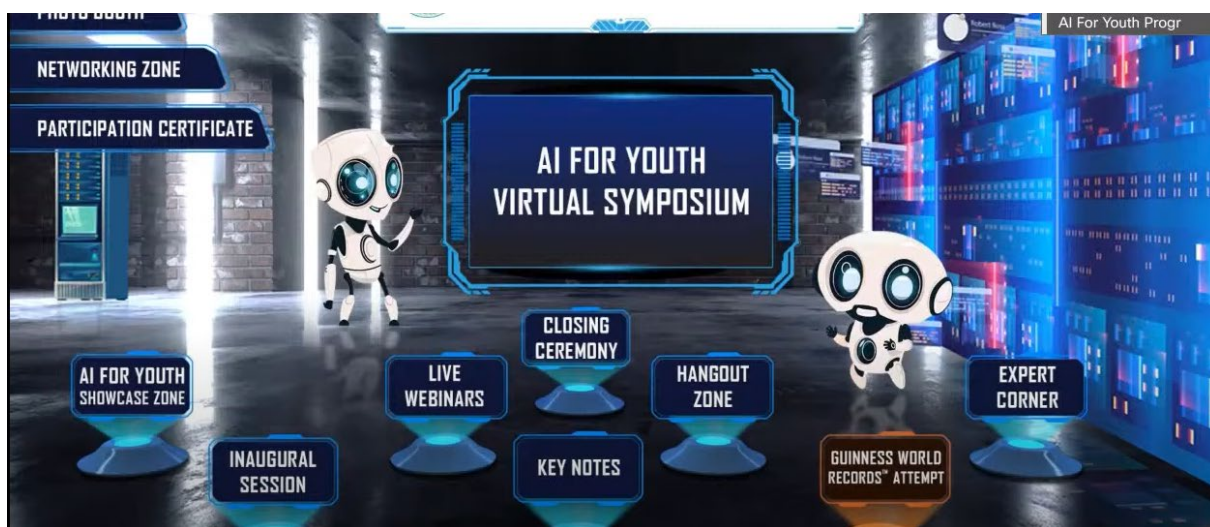
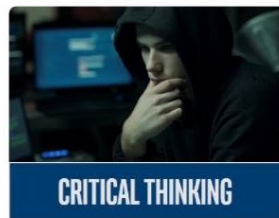
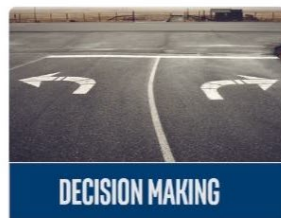
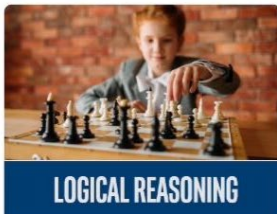
