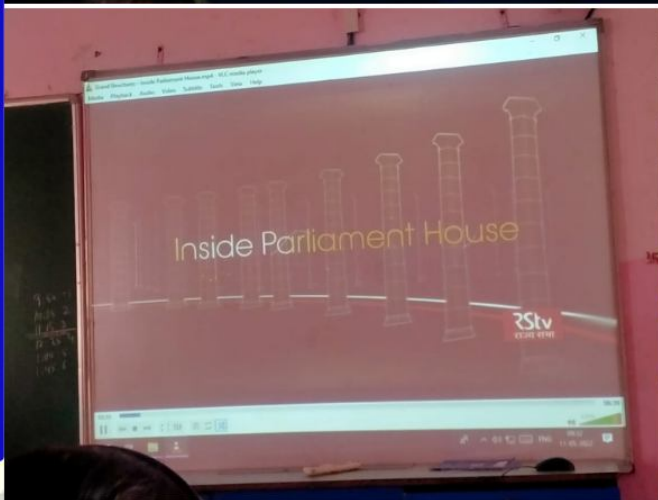
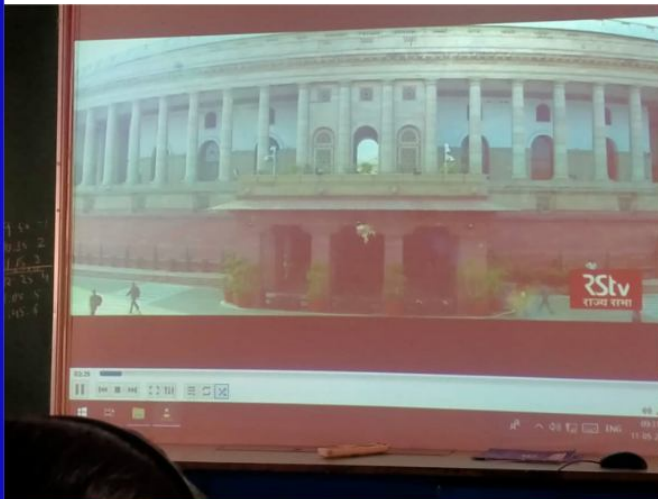


Virtual Trip to Parliament of India

- 1 → Parliament house building was designed by British architects • Edwin Lutyens & • Herbert Baker
- 2 → This iconic building was inaugurated in 1927 by Lord Irwin, then the Governor-General of India.
- 3 → The Parliament House comprises of a central hall which is circular in shape & 98 feet in Diameter.
- 4 → It also houses a museum which aims at educating people on "Democratic heritage of India."
- 5 → The domed circular central hall with oak paneled walls and the 3 semi-circular buildings are used for Rajya Sabha & Lok Sabha meetings.
