FUN WITH MATHEMATICS

HIGHLIGHTS OF SESSION - Basics activities to clear concepts of area, volume calculations. MAtheematical puzzle to solve.

Today, the students of Maharaja Agarsain Cambridge Wing from Cam-6 to Cam-8 went to the National Science Center, an educational excursion, to make the Mathematics more fun for the learners.

The session was started with a show named SOS (Science on Sphere) which discusses about the Solar System, especially talking about the Blue Planet - EARTH. It focussed on the flashback of Earth and highlighted the adverse effects she is facing due to human activities and motivated the students to understand that it's not too late and they must do everything which can help them to save their mother Earth.
