Dear Parents

The new session 2018-19 has brought in heartening news with our student Tarun Luthra of XII B (session 2017-18) winning a **scholarship of Rs. 50,000/- from Campus India**. Also, the Cambridge Wing of our school running classes from Mont I to Class VIII has successfully completed one year. Now the students have enrolled themselves in class IX and will be appearing for International General Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (i.e. IGCSE which is International Qualification equivalent to Class X CBSE Board) offered by University of Cambridge, U.K in the year 2020.

Missive International- Four of our students with three Science Projects are participating at ISEF (International Science & Engineering Fair) in Pittsburgh. The results will be declared on 18th May 2018 and can be checked on the school website a day later. Agarsainians have an enviable track-record of success at ISEF, winning awards and accolades year after year. We are sure this year too, our students will bring back laurels like their trail-blazing predecessors who brought glory to the school and the nation with resounding success at ISEF.

Vacations are a time for rejuvenation and provide a welcome break from routine. The school closes for the Summer Vacation from **21st May 2018** except for classes X & XII and reopens on 2nd July 2018.

Special Classes for Class X & XII- The school has arranged extra classes for Classes X & XII from 19th May to 26th May 2018 from 7.30 a.m onwards. The extra classes will be over for Class X and the students of Class XII with 5 subjects at 12.45 pm and for those with Physical Education and Music as 6th Additional subject, at 1.45 pm. The syllabus covered during these classes will not be repeated. Therefore, it is imperative that the students attend these classes else a fine of Rs. 200/- per subject per day will be imposed. For any unavoidable circumstance, prior permission for leave must be sought **by the parents** from the Principal. Application brought by the students will not be considered. The school library will remain open from 08.30 a.m. to 1.45 p.m. from 19.05.2018 to 26.05.2018 to facilitate the students to acquire resource material/books.

1st Terminal exam- Approximately 50% syllabus has been covered in Classes X & XII. To reiterate the learning and help the students know their weak areas, the 1st Terminal exams for class X & XII will commence from 2nd July 2018 as per the date sheet given on Page -30 of the School Almanac. Therefore, please ensure that your ward utilizes his/her time to the maximum to prepare for these exams. A fine of Rs. 200/- per paper will be charged for remaining absent and for poor performance (Less than 33% marks). The students scoring below 33% will have to reappear for the respective paper. The fine will not be exempted under any circumstances.

WEB PORTAL -In an attempt to streamline academic, financial and administrative processes and provide a completely paperless environment, school has upgraded its existing **WEB PORTAL** from Campuscare to **Edunext**, as it has more facilities.

Please note that the students will be tested and marked for the holiday homework after the vacations so encourage them to complete the Home Work on his/her own under your supervision. Some important guidelines for safe internet usage have also been provided with the summer assignments available on the webportal.
