

MATHS WEEK- PRIMARY (27.04.2018-07.05.2018)



MAPS allows kids to imagine, experience, explore, create, observe and use the sense in a much more creative manner. With this aim, Maths Week was conducted from 27th April to 7th May 2018 and students participated in it wholeheartedly.

The theme of class 1 was “STACKING THE SPIRE”. Students learnt to arrange the numbers in descending order in a fun way and worked as a team.

The theme of class 2 was “HARMONIZE SQUARE”. Students created pictures using different 2-D shapes or objects using 3-D shapes and tessellation kit followed by hurdle race on the final day. It was a 100% participation.

The theme of class 3 was “MATHMEMOIR”. Students represented story on their topic given like Fraction, Time, Money followed by 3 questions asked by the teacher. The best group of each section was selected for inter class activity.



The theme of class 4 was “NUMEROLOGY”. The students in groups made puzzle cards, letter cards (M,A,T,H,S) and answer cards. They collected all answer cards and letter cards. The group who finished first and collected all letter cards was selected for Inter class competition.



The theme of class 5 was “GEOMETROCITY”. Students created a Geometrocity with their own imagination using old boxes of different shapes, nets of solids. They participated with full zeal and energy and showcased their talent. It was 100% participation. The result are as follows:
