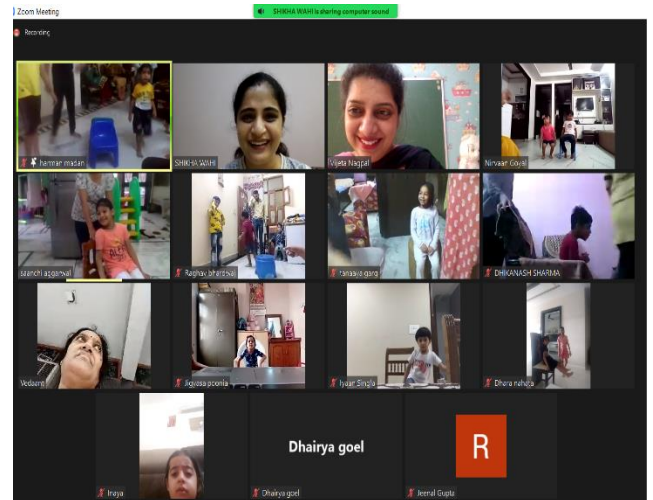
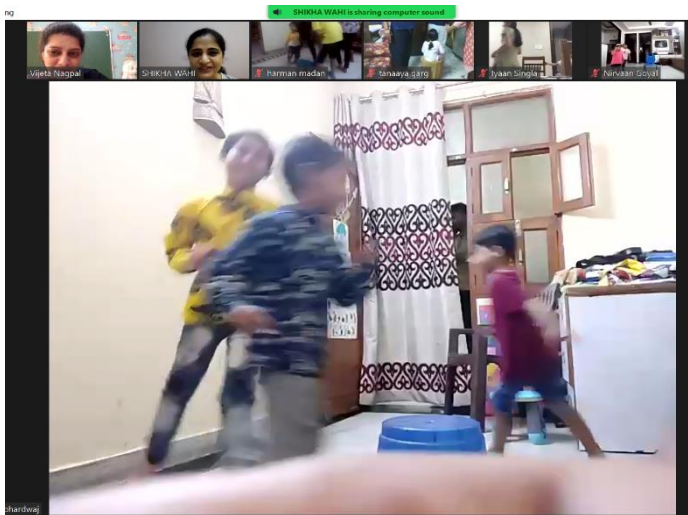


**REPORT – MUSICAL CHAIR**
