The primary objective of the Sensory Popcorn Frost activity was to continue the exploration of popcorn using various sensory elements, with a focus on building popcorn snowmen using disposable glasses. The day's emphasis was on encouraging the children to describe the popcorn using their sense organs and enhancing their vocabulary related to sensory experiences. In the activity students were provided with a disposable glass to represent the snowman's body. Guidance was given to children in stacking the decorated glasses on top of each other to create a snowman shape and they were asked to use their sense organs to describe the popcorn. Day 6 of the Sensory Popcorn Frost activity continued to engage children in a rich sensory experience, combining creativity, teamwork, and descriptive language skills. The hands-on exploration of popcorn, along with the construction of popcorn snowmen, provided a memorable and educational experience for the participating children. The day's focus on sensory descriptions contributed to the development of their language and observation skills.
