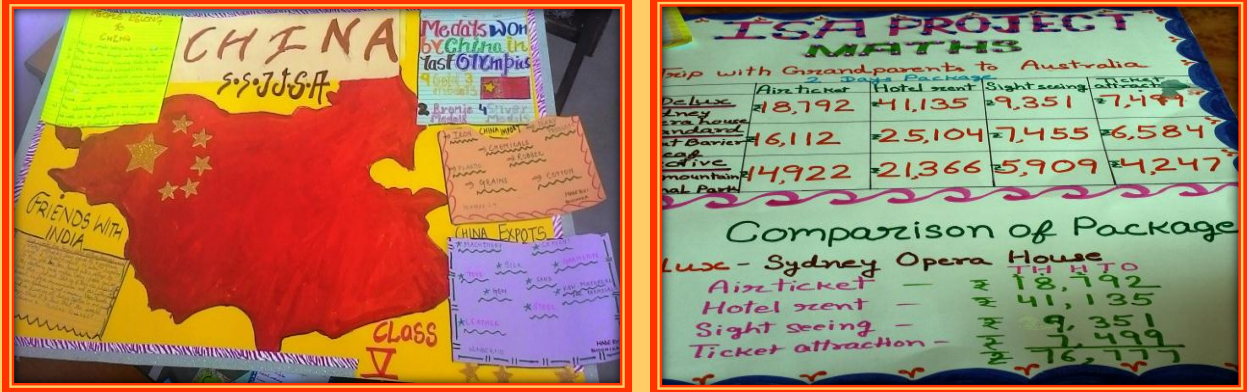


MAPS EXPO' 16
